1. Summer events are divided into MISSIONAL (♦) and FELLOWSHIP (⚡) events.
2. Fellowship events are movie nights, trivia nights, cooking lessons, and church picnic. They are designed for families to enjoy the event together.
3. Missional events are family focused. Both parents and children need to participate.
4. Sign up with Nicholas for the animal shelter AND inform the Cuero Animal Shelter you are coming to volunteer. Families do not have to attend only on a Tuesday. **Wednesday and Thursday volunteer days are available but are not scheduled.**
5. **DO NOT SIGN UP EVERY MISSIONAL WEEK.** Decide as a family which weeks you can be available to work. Nicholas will be at the library or shelter every other week specified in the schedule.
6. Cooking days have limited spots. Parents, if you feel comfortable with your child around heat and sharp objects sign them up. In addition parents you will need to stay for the event as a taste tester. (Or parents can also help in the kitchen)
