- 1. CALL TO ORDER- The meeting of the Church Council of St. Paul Lutheran Church was called to order by Boyd Wiese, President. Terry Carmicheal and Katie Serrano were also in attendance.
- 2. **DEVOTION-** Laurey Garcia provided the devotion.
- 3. **MINUTES-** Laurey Garcia made a motion to accept the May 14, 2024, minutes as presented. Jay Heil seconded the motion. The motion carried.

4. REPORTS-

- a. **Treasurer/Stewardship-** Calvin Bruns provided a written report.
- b. Parish Education-Jill Turner reported:
 - 1. VBS- Tina said we have 65 kids registered. Material was ordered last week, and we included a banner for the church lawn and 3 signs to put around town. The ad is in the Yorktown paper and will run until the week before bible school. Tina will let me know when the signs arrive, and I will get them up and placed.

 - 3. Sunday school teacher meeting is scheduled for June 23rd after Sunday school. We will discuss how

 - 3. Thanks to Pam Hoefling for arranging to get an Ice Maker purchased and installed in the Fellowship Hall Kitchen.
 - 4. The church elevator continues to be a sore spot. It is working presently, but apparently has an

intermittent problem that the technician from TKE has been unable to isolate. We have several individuals trained in how to release the doors should the problem reoccur.
